TRAINING SOCIAL WORKERS IN THE PREVENTION OF NATURAL HAZARDS AND THE CONSEQUENCES OF CLIMATE CHANGE – TAKING ACTION TO PRESERVE OUR PLANET

This last 14 months have been particularly complicated to manage our activities, produce remotely and ensure productions, including IO.3 and IO.4.

We proceeded, due to the health crisis, mainly through videoconference meetings within the partnership and ensured bilateral contacts to process our productions with a view to future management.

Workshops to process our productions remotely.

To maintain the momentum of the project and ensure a good progress of the Social & Nature project, we have beyond the bilateral meetings, work in workshops during a day of collective work.

IO.3 whose objective is to develop training content on the phenomena, consequences, prevention and resilience of climate change.

It aims to develop a "New Culture of Climate Change and its impacts in Europe". It is part of the partnership's desire to provide formative content for social workers on the theme of climate change.

Thus, the IO.3 "Skills and training content" is totally linked to the IO.4 "skills and training content on social cohesion in collective projects".

Once social workers are familiar with climate change issues, they learn how to involve civil society and public actors in collective projects. The new skills framework and learning path and content for IO.3 is almost finalized.



It remains to process and finalize the content of the IO.4.

The workshops were an inspiring source for redefining and adjusting the modules around these notions of social cohesion and participation.

IASIS and ENAIIP worked on the theme "*Bottom-up approach/Citizens' Initiatives*".

MCE and ITG on "*Benchmarks and Challenges/Opportunities and blocking factors*".

UNESSA and IFRTS on "*Initiative transformed in project mode /Efficiency approaches*".

The workshops have made it possible to give coherence to this IO.4 production by avoiding duplication with IO.3 and the work currently being processed by the partners will allow in the coming weeks the piloting of the planned actions.

Each country will invite future social workers and social professionals to benefit from tools via tests during the experimentation phase. For these people, it is a question of testing the relevance of the productions carried out and of measuring the interest of integrating these tools within their respective structures. The objective is of course to better support their own beneficiary audience.

We call on the different educators of the partnership to get closer to their structure to be able to participate and register for the test phase of the proposed training content.
